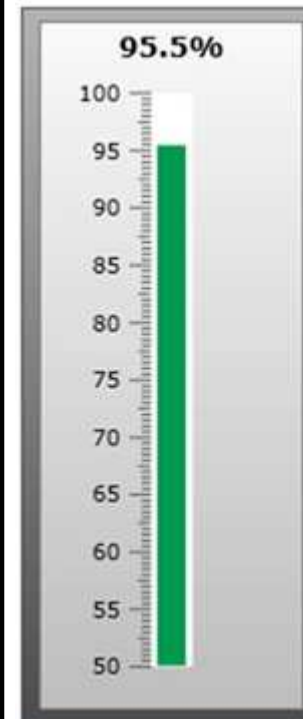
Welcome to Week 9!

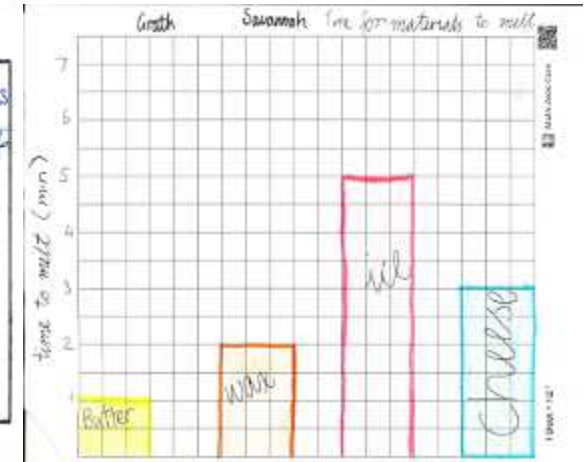
